WARBLINGTON IS A GOOD SCHOOL!

The Ofsted report published on 30th September 2014 states the fact that “the Governing Body and Senior Leaders have established an ethos of high expectations in all aspects of the school’s work which is leading to rapid improvements in teaching and achievement.” They comment that standards are now “rising sharply” and that “students feel safe and behave well.” “The students’ positive attitude is contributing to their learning and progress and the students are very proud of their school.” “Teaching is good with some that is outstanding.”

Quality of Teaching—Good

- “Training for staff is of high quality and is now a strength of the school.”
- “There is a major focus on improving literacy skills in all subjects.”
- “Teachers use questioning effectively to promote students’ understanding of work.”
- “Teaching at its best enthuses and inspires students of all abilities.”

Behaviour and Safety—Good

- “Students are extremely courteous to each other, their teachers and to other adults.”
- “The majority of students enjoy learning and they display positive attitudes and perseverance.”
- “The School’s work to keep students safe and secure is good.”
- “Students report that bullying is rare.”
- “The students show a great pride in their own appearance and that of the school.”

Leadership and Management—Good

- “Staff are proud to work at the school.”
- “Leaders have created a climate within the school where there is a strong desire among teachers to improve their practice and so the achievement of students.”
- “Students’ spiritual, moral, social and cultural development is well developed.”
- “The school’s own view about its performance is accurate.”
- “The Headteacher and Deputy Headteacher have been relentless in their drive to improve the school. Their success is evident in the improvement and achievement of students.”

Achievement—Good

- “Since 2013 progress has been increasing and continues to improve.”
- “Progress has improved significantly in 2014 and is now good.”
- “Current students eligible for extra funding are now making much better progress.”
- “The whole school focus on raising literacy levels has been successful.”
